



**Sublimity Fire District
Safety Committee Minutes
May 29, 2008**

Call to order: Angela Hargin called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m.

Reading of Minutes: The minutes from April 21, 2008, were approved.

Old Business: Dumpster Curb—The committee discussed the possibility of building a curb out of 2x6s to keep the dumpster in place during high winds. It has been traveling when it's windy.

MSDS—Angela has gone through all the chemicals and MSDS sheets again to make sure that everything is up to date. Station 52 needs to have its MSDS sheets reviewed. The committee thought it would be easiest to have Tim take care of that task. Angela and Hayley said they would mention it at drill.

Safety board—The group agreed that it looked good, but should be better advertised to the department. The safety information has also been posted at Station 52. The committee received no suggestions or feedback in the way of forms.

New Business: The committee asked the new chief if he had any personal safety concerns or suggestions. He feels that the mezzanine is overloaded and too cluttered. It's a project that will be dealt with this summer.

The group discussed the issue of new outlets for the upstairs bedrooms. Hayley mentioned that all of the rooms have at least one power strip plugged in 24/7. The group feels that that is a hazard and brought it to the attention of the chief. The district got a bid for that project, but because of unforeseen costs relating to the AFG Grant, was unable to afford it in the current budget year. The chief will look at completing the project in the next budget year.

There was discussion about the district's respiratory policy and what information needs to be posted on the board.

It was brought up at the SDAO board training that the district should have a “job description.” Paulette Oliver said that it was a requirement. That is something to be aware of, but it’s up to the board to come up with the description.

Hayley hasn’t had any safety committee training yet. Amy will keep her eyes open for training opportunities.
