Old Business: Kamerer's turnouts still need to be washed. Upon inspection, the turnouts were damaged. It appears that someone removed the American flag patch from the shoulder and, in so doing, put a hole in the coat. The turnout coat was placed out of service until it can be repaired.

Geoff researched testing/inspection tags and brought some examples to the committee. The committee made a decision and it was forwarded to Amy to make the purchase.

OSHA was contacted online regarding a walk-through. The automated response said that someone would contact the district in 5-7 business days.

New Business: The biohazard box is full. Nick Lane contacted Marion Environmental Services. They will be bringing a new box. It was noted that if the box weighs more than 40 lbs or if it is not sealed, they won't take it.

After an incident with a firefighter having fiberglass in his laundry, it has been determined that the washer needs to be more clearly marked with a sign that says: MUST INSPECT WASHER AND CYCLE IT THROUGH ONCE AFTER WASHING TURNOUTS.

People who went on the fire last Thursday in Stayton need to wash their turnouts. Geoff will notify them. (Brandon, Angela, Brock, Nick, David)
