

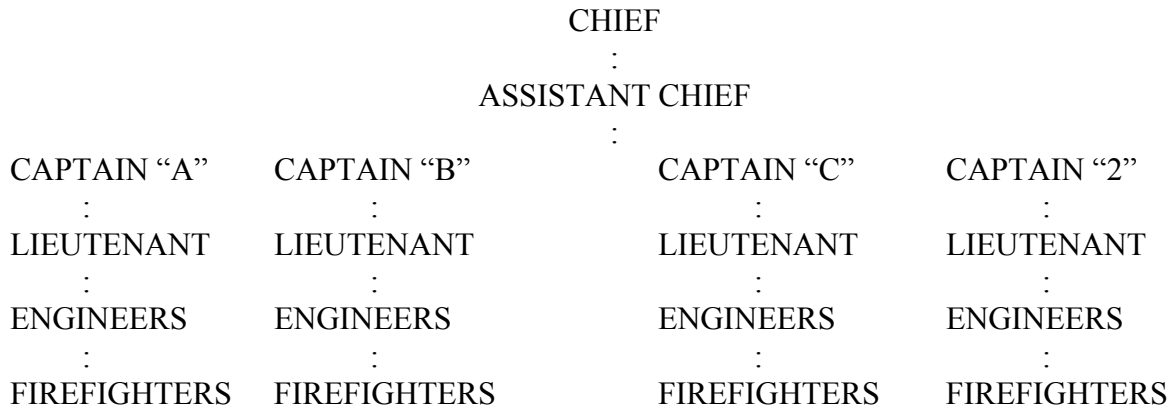

OPERATIONS STRUCTURE

The fire district will utilize the operational chart listed below, to conduct day-to-day operations.



1. The Fire Chief holds the number one position in the operations structure. Number of positions: one
2. The Assistant Chief holds the number two position in the operational structure. Number of positions: one.
3. The Captains positions are the number three position in the operational structure. Number of positions: One per company.
4. The Lieutenants positions are the number four position in the operational structure. Number of positions: one per company at station one, two positions for station two.
5. The Engineers positions are the number five position in the operational structure. Number of positions: unlimited.
6. The Firefighters positions are the number six position in the operational structure.
7. The station at 115 NW Parker St., Sublimity, will be known as Station one (1). The station at 5000 Drift Creek Rd. SE, Sublimity, will be known at Station two (2).
8. Since station one has sufficient personnel, it will be divided into three companies, A, B, and C. Station two will utilize a single company formation, but will have one captain and two lieutenants.
