ENGINEER

GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES

Performs emergency and non emergency functions for the fire district. Drives and operates fire district apparatus. Performs maintenance, readiness checks and assures restoration of apparatus after responses and training.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED

Works under the direction of assigned company officers.

SUPERVISION EXERCISED

May exercise supervision over Firefighters in the absence of an officer.

PRINCIPLE DUTIES

- Attends drills on a regular basis and maintains skills as required by the Fire District.
- Promotes unity within the District
- Responds to emergencies, works under the supervision of the company officer and performs duties to bring the situation under control.
- Forwards requests for maintenance or repairs to the appropriate officer(s)
- Helps to maintain apparatus, facilities and equipment
- Performs cleanup work and overhaul after emergency.
- Assists in returning apparatus and equipment to response status, fully cleaned and restored.
- Promotes safety of self and others
- Performs within the scope/ policies and procedures of the fire district.
- May function in the capacity of company officer, when company officer is absent
- Drives and operates Fire District apparatus as assigned.
- Performs preventative maintenance of apparatus and equipment.
- Responsible for Restoring apparatus and equipment to a ready state after use.
- Works in the capacity of Firefighter when not assigned to an apparatus as Driver.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

All individuals must meet the following requirements to be considered for the position of Engineer.

- Meet all of the BASIC FIREFIGHTER requirements. (2.1.07)
- Completed the BPSST Driver course.
- Have completed all course work for _DPSST Pumper Operator 4 accreditation
- Pass the Apparatus Operator I Task Performance
- Have the recommendation of the individuals currents company Captain and Lieutenant.
