## Operating Guidelines

### Operating Guidelines

The Sublimity Rural Fire Protection District has established Operating Guidelines as its operational rules, regulations and procedures. The Fire Chief is responsible to supervise, maintain and administer the fire district and its personnel.

This Operating Guideline manual is applicable to all personnel in the Sublimity Fire District.

1. Each Officer is responsible to:
  - a) Review and comprehend the information contained in this manual.
  - b) Carry out the direction given in these guidelines in a consistent manner.
  - c) Assist Fire District members in comprehending and following the guidelines set forth in this manual.
  
2. Each Member is responsible to:
  - a) Read, understand and follow the guidelines set forth in this manual.
  - b) Review the contents of this document on an annual basis.

The unique demands of emergency incidents may require operations or procedures, which are not covered within these guidelines. Any deviation from these Operating Guidelines may be made as the situation dictates as long as no violation of basic safety standards occurs. Such deviations may be reviewed by the Officers of the district to determine the necessity and result of the action or actions. Deliberate deviation from these guidelines when not appropriate is just cause for further investigation and possible disciplinary action.

The Officers may recommend guidelines, or revisions, to the Fire Chief, who approves them for use in fire district operations by all Fire District Personnel.
