### UNIFORMS

The fire district uniform standard will include shirt, pants footwear, belt, and jackets. The uniform may be worn when representing this fire department, or as directed by the chief or company officer.

The fire district will provide a uniform shirt to each member after they have completed their probation. The fire district will also replace any damaged uniform shirt at no more than one every two years. It is the members responsibility to keep the uniform clean and presentable.

#### SHIRT

The uniform shirt shall be medium blue for members during their probation. After probation all members will be issued a navy blue Nomex shirt. All shirts will be short sleeve. All but the top button of the shirt will be buttoned. Insignia allowed on the shirt will be limited to;

1. Department patch on the left sleeve. The top of the patch will be one inch down from the seam.
2. EMT or First Responder patch on the right sleeve. The top of the patch will be one inch down from the seam..
3. The department badge above the left chest pocket, in the badge tab.
4. Cloth name plate sewn on the right chest above the pocket flap.
5. Rank insignia on the collar (FD for firefighters)

Class A's will include a white shirt. For all officers and a light blue shirt for all firefighters and engineers if so equipped.

#### PANTS

Navy Blue Nomex will be worn with the shirt.

#### FOOTWEAR

Footwear will be black dress shoes or boots (these are not issued by the Fire District)

### JACKETS Class A--

A double breasted CPO jacket will be used as the jacket for the class A uniform. Chief, Asst Chief and Captains will wear Black Pants and coats with Class A's Lieutenants and below will wear Navy Blue Pants and coats with Class A's

With the following insignia;

1. Braided stripes on the sleeves to indicate rank;
  - A. 1- 1/2" gold Braid and 1- 2" gold braid for chief
  - B. 4 - 1/2" gold Braid for assistant chief
  - C. 3- 1/2" gold Braid for captain
  - D. 2- 1/2" gold Braid for lieutenant
  - E. 1- 1/2" gold Braid for engineers
  - F. 1- 1/2" Blue Braid for fire fighters
2. One Maltese cross on the right sleeve, 1/2" above the uppermost braid centered on the left sleeve for each 5 years on the department.
3. Badge above the left chest pocket.
4. Name tag below the badge.

The jacket approved by the Association will be the jacket used for the class B or lower uniform.

### BELT

The belt will be determined by the pants worn.

1. Blue jeans - black or brown.
2. Slacks - black leather belt.

### NAME TAG

The name tag will have the persons rank and last name.

### TIE

A tie is optional. Navy blue tie worn with a blue shirt and black tie worn with a white shirt. All tie worn must be a break away type.

### HATS

Only fire department authorized hats may be worn with the uniform shirt.

### COVERALLS

Coveralls must be navy blue, and may have the same insignia as the uniform shirt.

It is the intent of the fire district to express a positive image to the public through our personnel and actions. It is each members responsibility to see that he or she is well dressed. CAUTION: The use of mirrored sun glasses can present a arrogant image of the wearer. It is highly recommended that they not be worn with the uniform.
